"The Most Awarded Winery in Texas"

- Over 1400 medals and awards
- 1st and only Texas winery to receive "Top All-Around Winery" at the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo

- Messina Hof was the 4th winery established in the state of Texas in 1977.
- Messina Hof has grown from producing only 1,300 gallons to now over **150,000 gallons** per year with **3 locations** in Texas (Bryan, Fredericksburg, and Grapevine.)

LOCAL

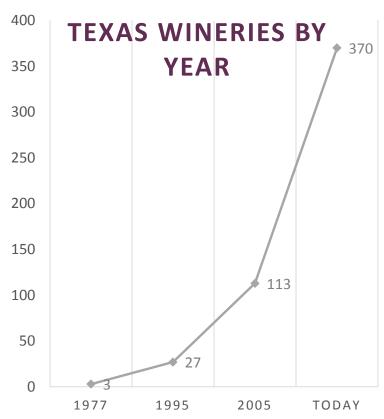
People seek out authentic goods with a good story from the region they visit or live.

- A winery is rooted in a local community becoming a part of the local culture.
- Most Texas wineries are located in population centers and are easily accessible for tourists. Approximately 95% of Texas wine is consumed locally.
- **34**% of consumers are "specifically looking to immerse themselves in the destinations they visit and to travel like a local"

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TEXAS WINE INDUSTRY

Texas is the site of the 1st vineyard in North America, which was established in 1662 by Franciscan priests.

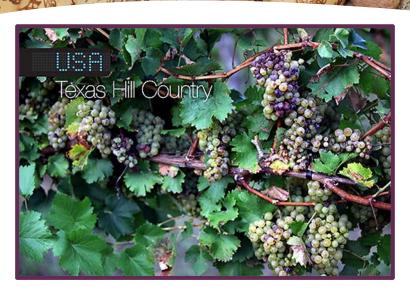
